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Our history

A youth-led organisation

"I WATCH" is a **non-profit and independent Tunisian watchdog organisation** that aims to combat corruption and enhance transparency. I WATCH became the official point of contact for Transparency International in Tunisia in November 2013 and since January 29th, 2017, the national branch of Transparency International in Tunisia. The organisation was founded **following the Tunisian revolution on March 21st, 2011**. It includes a group of young men and women active in various regions of the republic and all of them work to preserve the gains of the revolution.

I WATCH is based on **two principles**:

No to exclusion: The organisation does not exclude anyone based on a religious, political, ideological or regional background.

No trusteeship: "I WATCH" believes in the youthful energies of Tunisia. The youth who made the revolution have the qualifications that make them trustworthy. The organisation works to include young people in the decision-making system and rejects trusteeship in any way due to lack of experience.

The organisation has **two main goals**:



Transparency

"I WATCH" works to ensure transparency of political demonstrations and electoral processes in all their stages.



Anti-corruption

"I WATCH" believes that corruption is among the causes of the outbreak of the revolution. In 2022, during its general assembly, IWATCH added the "consumer protection" to the organization's scope of work. This aims to facilitate the strategic litigation and to focus on taxpayers' daily problems.

Our Vision

Engaging and innovating against corruption

I WATCH believes that the fight against corruption requires the use of innovative solutions and approaches to anti-corruption action and the raising of awareness. Such solutions and approaches involve considering cultural activities to raise awareness about corruption and the use of IT and communication technologies to report corruption.

Our Organizational Ethics: I WATCH adheres to high standards of legal compliance and ethics. We commit to be fully accountable and transparent towards our beneficiaries, partners and donors, by providing access to information regarding the allocation and management of funds. I WATCH has an **inspection department** which is responsible for elaborating codes of conduct and monitors compliance with internal regulations and national laws. Moreover, I WATCH has an **Ethics Officer**, with a temporary mandate, who performs several important tasks: Installing incorporating ethics cultures in management personnel; Establishing reporting channels for employees to use without fear of retaliation; Enforcing ethical codes, raising recommendations to improve the organization's Rules of and lead on the ethics unit during IWATCH's big scale events.

Our Governance Structure

I WATCH governance comprises of two main levels:

- The **associative** governance
- The **organisational & operational** governance

The associative governance is composed of the following **two bodies**:

The General Assembly (GA)

The General Assembly is the governing body of I WATCH. The members of the association meet twice a year for a General Assembly and whenever required for an extraordinary General Assembly (GA). The Ordinary and the Extraordinary GA have the following core responsibilities:

- a)** To endorse the Moral Report.
- b)** To endorse the financial statements, annual accounts, statutory auditor's report & allocate incomes.
- c)** To elect the members of the Board of Directors.
- d)** To review the strategic plan and main strategic organisational developments.
- e)** To amend the organisation articles if required.

The Board of Directors (BoD)

The BoD is elected by the General Assembly and is composed of a president, general secretary and treasurer. It is in charge of defining the overall strategy of the organisation. This BoD has the following core responsibilities:

- a)** To oversee the strategic plan and main strategic development directions of the organisation.
- b)** To endorse the organisational ethics, policies and code of conduct, and oversee the overall legal compliance of the organisation.

The organisational & operational governance is composed of **a steering committee**

The Steering committee:

It is led by **two members** who have delegated **authority from the BoD**. It is the strategic upper management of the organisation and the key decision-making body with regards to IWATCH's **strategy development, positioning, alignment and risk management**.

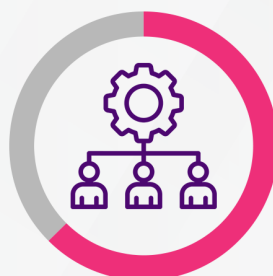

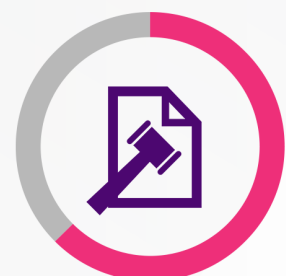

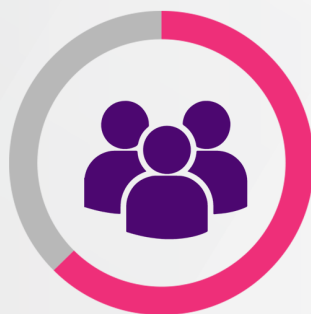

I WATCH's Impact stories

Yakedh Advocacy & Legal Advice Center (YALAC)



Raising citizens' voices: YALAC have received and followed up on hundreds of cases of corruption reported by citizens.

I WATCH filed **4 cases** before the penal judiciary, **9 cases** before administrative court; and received **326 alerts** from whistleblowers. Using the access to information law, YALAC team filled in 2022, **130 requests** before several institutions such as ministries, head of government, municipalities and public administrations.

I WATCH's Impact stories

I CUBE Program



Launched in 2020, I Cube is an **unprecedented incubator program** dedicated to the **consolidation of the capacities of civil society** in Tunisia. By providing core funding, it aims to accelerate the growth of partner CSOs in order to help them advance to the next level in terms of financing, structuring, impact, and stability, striving to solidify the associations' infrastructures and thus their sustainability.

In 2022, we provided **tailored support to 9 incubated CSOs** (located in Jendouba, Kasserine, Gafsa, Gabes, Djerba, Medenine, and Tozeur) on the following thematic: Strategic Planning, Financial Management, Advocacy and Communication, Policy Analysis, Digitizing Internal Processes, Management, Fundraising, Strategy and Partnerships (Networking). The ICUBE first cohort will manage a total budget of **1817974,05TND**.

I WATCH's Impact stories

I-TOUR by IWATCH: Mobile Van



IWATCH put at the disposal of radio associations a mobile Studio “I-TOUR” to use it for their broadcasts. The I TOUR was launched from the south of Tunisia (Tataouine) and reached Tunis at the end of the trip. **18 local radios broadcasted shows** using our Mobile Van for a total of **67, 5 hours of Live**. In addition, **15 live shows by SON FM** were broadcasted during the TOUR and discussed the local priorities of every region with community leaders, citizens, and activists. I-Tour visited **17 governorates** and **25 towns** in **25 days**.

IWATCH launched its FM community radio SON FM which broadcasts on **100.00FM in Grand Tunis** and on www.Sonfm.tn. The radio station strives to promote **integrity, combat corruption, and amplify the voices of underrepresented groups.**

It offers regular news broadcasts and a diverse range of cultural programs, including "Pause-café," a weekly show focused on Tunisian civic society, and "Son24," which covers local and regional news and issues within the community. SON Fm has **11 full-time staff members and 10 IWATCH staff members** who contribute to the production and the animation of RadioShows. SON FM (By IWATCH) broadcasted live shows from the most vulnerable regions in the country: Hassi El Ferid & Sidi Makhoul in an attempt to ensure equality and inclusiveness.

"MAC" – Month Against Corruption

The event "Month against corruption", is "the **largest anti-corruption manifestation in Tunisia**", dedicated to the promotion of **transparency values and fight against corruption**. The "Month Against Corruption" event, also known as "MAC," has become a highly anticipated annual initiative in Tunisia. The ninth edition of the event aimed to bring together individuals from diverse backgrounds to participate in a range of activities aimed at promoting anti-corruption efforts in the country. **841 participants attended 78 activities** and artistic performances addressing issues related to integrity, freedom of expression, impunity and corruption were organized in the 24 governorates. It took place between December 2022 and January 2023.

ICHECK by IWATCH



ICheck is a platform dedicated to **fact-checking and fighting media deception**. It follows international standards, journalistic codes, and ethical principles to ensure accuracy, impartiality, transparency, and reliability. ICheck prioritizes political news, focuses on public interest, and avoids biased opinions. It also refrains from checking news that harms women or children, promotes negative polemics culture, or causes conflicts of interest. In 2022, ICheck published **17 blogs on its website**. The platform is committed to transparency and corrects mistakes quickly, notifies readers of errors, and leaves comments open. For instance, ICheck corrected an article **claiming the IMF had canceled a meeting about Tunisia's financing program** by researching multiple sources and correcting the article after the file was removed on December 15th.

Shbebek by IWATCH



Launched in 2020, Shbebek continues to promote **freedom of expression and defend human rights** through the production of engaging and interactive stories and digital programs that are tailored to the interests and needs of citizens across Tunisia. On average, Shbebek publications receive around **249,845 views** and **3,615 reactions**.

IWATCH Communities



I WATCH Communities are **citizens' hubs that bring together our partners in municipalities**, representatives of regional administrations, citizens, volunteers, CSOs. The communities are created to become a hub for citizens of exchange knowledge, policy analysis and advocacy platform on a local level. The communities are open to all citizens and meet monthly. Between August and September 2022, I WATCH conducted **8 meetings and a series of interviews** with its communities in Tataouine, Kbeli, Jendouba, Gafsa, Gasserine, Tunis, Manouba and Sousse where we gathered Male and Female Citizens, Municipal Actors, Representatives of CSOs, Representatives of Regional Offices of Agriculture, Culture, Women and Tourism to get to understand their concerns and to get to know their feedback and opinions about **specific issues related to public interest**.

Engaging for Sustainability Climate Justice Camp



IWATCH hosted **the Climate Justice Camp in Tunisia**, a significant event that took place from **September 26th to 30th, 2022**, in the governorate of Nabeul. This camp aligned with the organization's **vision for the years 2022-2025**, where environmental issues are prioritized as a strategic focus in their work, recognizing the importance of the environment sector and its impact on developmental sectors. The camp was organized in partnership with global and local organizations actively involved in environmental affairs, and it was the largest event of its kind in the North Africa and Middle East region. Around **400 participants of different nationalities** from southern countries attended the camp, where they discussed and planned solutions for significant environmental problems facing the region and the world due to climate change. Participants included leaders and members of civil society organizations from 65 countries, including North Africa, the Middle East, Latin America, Southeast Asia, and Sub-Saharan Africa, who all sought to achieve climate justice. During the Climate Justice Camp, IWATCH focused on raising awareness of the effects of corruption and impunity for climate change and the environment in general. The event was held before the Conference of the Parties (COP) to the **United Nations Framework** Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) for the year 2022, also known as COP27, which took place in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt.
